IV. 2015 Wants/ Needs/ Ideas:

- A. Signage – No Dogs in Park; Trail distance signs; playground distance signs & rules.
- B. Park Benches – upgrade, research the benches that were purchased for Village Hall.
- C. Park Trail – The trail needs some maintenance of mulch and stone. Plans to use the FCI workers to help with the project. Mockler has been designated to work with the FCI and possibly the school for meals if the FCI workers are available. It was suggested to create a tri-fold advertising the park conveniences to have available at the Motel and other establishments; Hockerman will be working on that.
- D. Meadowbrook – requires some maintenance the stone base has disappeared over time; concrete base is exposed of the park toys. Mockler will be looking into some sort of edging to hold the replacement sand within its confines.
- E. Oak Heights – Replace culvert.

- F. Maintenance of the Veterans Park –The Village will continue to maintain the park but looking for help in regard to the beautification of the Park. Hockerman will contact Land & Water so see what grant money is available.

Consensus is to maintain all the Park improvements while building savings for future projects.
